**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CANCELLING  
PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Prehearing Officer finds and concludes as follows:

1.        On September 11, 2017, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an Application to extend five of its Demand-Side Management (DSM) programs for an additional five years and to terminate one of its DSM programs.<sup>1</sup>

2.        On October 10, 2017, the Commission approved a joint motion by KCP&L, Commission Staff (Staff) and the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) for an interim order continuing the DSM programs during the pendency and consideration in this Docket.<sup>2</sup>

3.        On April 17, 2018, Staff filed their Report and Recommendation (R&R).

4.        On April 27, 2018, CURB filed a reply to Staff's R&R.

5.        On May 7, 2018, KCP&L filed a response to Staff's R&R and to CURB's reply.

On the same date, Staff responded to CURB's reply.

6. On May 17, 2018, CURB responded to KCP&L and Staff.

7. On June 28, 2018, the Commission designated a Prehearing Officer pursuant to K.S.A. 77-551(c) to address matters in accordance with K.S.A. 77-516-517 and scheduled the matter for a prehearing conference on July 17, 2018.<sup>3</sup>

8. On July 6, 2018, the Parties submitted a Joint Motion to Approve Settlement Agreement and attached a Settlement Agreement resolving all current issues in the Docket.

9. Pursuant to the Prehearing Officer's delegation under K.S.A. 77-551(c) to handle procedural matters, the Prehearing Officer finds the Prehearing Conference scheduled for July 17, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. shall be cancelled as a result of the pending settlement. The Commission takes the Motion and Settlement Agreement under advisement and will issue an order accordingly.

**THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:**

A. The Prehearing Conference scheduled for July 17, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. is cancelled.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
