**ORDER DESIGNATING NEW PREHEARING OFFICER**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

1.        On October 22, 2018, Abercrombie Energy, LLC (Operator) filed an Application to authorize injection of saltwater into the Mississippi formation at the Brown #1-26 well, located in Seward County, Kansas.<sup>1</sup> A hearing on the Application is currently scheduled for May 16, 2019.<sup>2</sup>
2.        The Commission designates Jonathan R. Myers, Assistant General Counsel, 266 N. Main Street, Suite 220, Wichita, KS 67202, 316-337-6245, [j.myers@kcc.ks.gov](mailto:j.myers@kcc.ks.gov), as the new Prehearing Officer.<sup>3</sup> The Prehearing Officer may conduct Prehearing Conferences necessary to address any appropriate matters, including all items listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b) of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). The Commission may designate other Staff members to serve in this capacity.

**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

- A.        Jonathan R. Myers is designated as the new Prehearing Officer.
