ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On July 22, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$1,000 for reported over-injection at the Peavey D #1 well.
- 2. Staff has reviewed this matter with Operator. It appears that Operator made a mathematical error while totaling up the monthly injection volumes in the Annual Injection Report ("U3C") submitted by Operator. Thus, the reported monthly injection volumes appeared to be within acceptable limits, but the reported yearly injection volume did not.
- 3. As Operator's mathematical error is apparent on the U3C form, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the July 22, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The Penalty Order issued in this docket is rescinded.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.
