In the Matter of One Point Technologies, Inc. Changing its Name to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. (IXC).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On March 4, 2021, One Point Technologies, Inc. (One Point) filed an Application requesting the Commission change its name in all Commission records to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. Staff recommends approval of this Application.

BACKGROUND:

The Commission derives its authority to supervise telecommunications public utilities from K.S.A. 66-1,188.

ANALYSIS:

One Point requests that the name on its Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Interexchange Telecommunications Service within the state of Kansas be changed to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. The Company states the change will not affect any services or rates provided to customers of the Company.

One Point was issued a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Interexchange Telecommunications Services on December 7, 2010 in Docket No. 11-OPTT-292-COC.

Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office and authorized to engage in business in Kansas. It is currently "active and in good standing" with the Secretary's Office. One Point is current with regard to payments to the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) and payment of Commission assessments. The Company has a current Annual Interrogatory on file.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of One Point Technologies, Inc.'s Application to change the name on its Certificate to provide Interexchange Telecommunications Services within the state of Kansas to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. The Company is reminded to notify the Commission immediately of any change in address or contact telephone numbers, file timely annual reports, maintain current registration with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office, and pay all Commission and KUSF assessments in a timely manner.
