MOTION REQUESTING FISCAL YEAR 2021 DOCKET FOR ELECTRIC SUPPLY LINE FILINGS, APPROVAL OF AN UPDATED ELECTRIC SUPPLY LINE FORM, AND TO CLOSE DOCKET

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively) submits the following Motion for various changes to the Electric Supply Line (EL) procedure and compliance docket:

1. In Docket No. 19-GIME-190-CPL (19-190 Docket), the Commission adopted a Staff recommendation to institute a formal process for receiving, reviewing, and processing Electric Supply Line (EL) notifications, applications, and approvals. Prior to that time, Staff had no record of the Commission either approving the then-current Form EL form or delegating its authority to Staff to approve the filings.¹

2. Subsequently, on July 16, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Opening an Annual Compliance Docket for Electric Supply Line Filings* (Order Opening Compliance Docket) in the above-captioned matter.² The Order Opening Compliance Docket established Docket No. 20-GIME-017-CPL as a repository docket to track all Electric Supply Line (EL) notifications, applications, and approvals for Fiscal Year 2020.³ It also directed all public utilities to file K.A.R. 82-12-3 applications and all K.A.R. 82-12-5(a) notices in the instant docket, and allowed public utilities to continue utilizing the then-existing Form EL for K.A.R. 82-12-3 filings.⁴

3. As part of the Order Opening Compliance Docket, the Commission set forth a procedure for approval of the EL applications. The process authorized Staff to review and approve or deny any EL applications made in the docket, but also provided for Commission review for any person or entity aggrieved by any Staff decision.⁵

4. Staff has found this compliance docket helpful in tracking EL notifications, applications, and approvals. Staff recommends the Commission continue initiating annual compliance dockets, in which all EL-related filings and notices for that fiscal year can be housed. Staff also recommends the Commission close the compliance dockets at the end of the given fiscal year so that only one compliance docket remains open during each fiscal period. This will allow Staff, various companies, and the public to access a particular EL form with greater ease based on the year it was filed.

5. Additionally, Staff made some minor edits to update Form EL to better capture pertinent information relating to the particular wire stringing application being filed. Attached to this Motion is a revised Form EL for Commission consideration and approval.

6. In summary, Staff requests the Commission grant this motion and (1) initiate an new EL compliance docket for Fiscal Year 2021 consistent with the Order Opening Compliance Docket in this matter (2) approve the attached and updated Form EL for use in the Fiscal Year 2021 docket, and (3) order the instant docket closed effective June 30, 2020.

Staff respectfully requests the Commission respond to this Motion on or before July
 1, 2020, so the new Form EL and new compliance docket can align with the Commission's Fiscal
 Year 2021.
