ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL OF RECORD

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") on the motion of Larry M. Cowger requesting an Order granting his withdrawal as counsel of record for Kansas Gas Service Company, a Division of ONEOK, Inc. ("Kansas Gas Service"), in the above-captioned docket. The Commission being duly advised in the premises makes the following findings and conclusions:

- 2. The Commission finds that Mr. Cowger has demonstrated good cause for granting his request for withdrawal and the substitution of Mr. DeCoursey as counsel of record for Kansas Gas Service in this matter. Mr. Cowger's request is reasonable and his motion should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- (A) The Motion to Withdraw as Counsel of Record for Kansas Gas Service filed by Larry M. Cowger in this matter on February 28, 2002 is hereby granted.
- (B) A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15) days of the date this Order is served. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing and three (3) days may be added to the above time frame.
- (C) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.
