PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On November 5, 2019, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Lawco Holdings, LLC (Operator) for one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-400 because Operator conducted unauthorized injection at the Radcliff #7-5 well.¹
 - 2. On December 2, 2019, Operator requested a hearing.²
- 3. At a January 15, 2020, prehearing conference, all parties agreed to the following procedural schedule:

4. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the

right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may

limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

5. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities

Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

6. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or any other

stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.³

7. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁴

THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:

A. The procedural schedule set forth in Paragraph 3 above is adopted.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
