

authority to authorize a change in a motor carrier's service.

II. STAFF'S STATEMENT OF FACTS

4. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-4-32, each applicant filing an application for an intrstate common carrier certificate shall provide the Commission with all information required to complete the application within 30 days of the original filing date or the application may be dismissed.

5. SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC submitted an application for a Certificate of Public Service to the Kansas Corporation Commission on January 15, 2015.

6. On or about January 20, 2015, and February 10, 2015, Commission Staff (Staff) forwarded notices of incomplete application status to SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC. SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC has failed to present the following items to the Commission as required to complete the application process:

- a. cargo insurance (Form H)
- b. liability insurance (Form E)
- c. attendance at safety meeting

7. SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC failed to properly complete the application and, therefore, is unable to demonstrate that it is in compliance with the Commission's regulations and other applicable state laws.

III. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

8. Due to SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC's failure to provide the requested items resulting in an incomplete application, Staff recommends the Commission dismiss its application for Certificate of Public Service, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-4-32.

IV. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9. Based on the available facts, the Commission finds that Staff's request to dismiss the application of SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC for Certificate of Public Service, is reasonable under the circumstances.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) The application of SEVEN SONS TRUCKING LLC of GARDNER KS, for a Certificate of Public Service is hereby dismissed.

(B) A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing and three (3) days shall be added to the above time frame. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).

(C) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.
