You are hereby notified that Benjamin M. Giles, has filed an Application with the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an exception to the 10-year temporary abandonment time limitations of K.A.R. 82-3-111(b) for his Whipple #2 oil well located in the NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 7-T26S-R5E, Butler County, Kansas.
