Dear Leo, I offer this response to your letter dated 6/20/23, KCC Investigation #CK-23-OC-1100.

Option 1) Submit written explanation, a statement of denial, or other materials contesting the allegations.

Beacon was working as a concrete subcontractor for Strickland Construction on the Church of the Harvest property. Our role was to form and pour concrete curb and sidewalk. This incident occurred while forming curb for a subsequent concrete pour. As you can see from the attached picture the 30" steel stake was projecting 11-1/4" +/- above the 2 X 12 (11-1/4") dimension lumber. That would leave 8" +/- of the steel stake protruding into the soil subgrade. Based on that scenario it appears that the damaged Atmos gas line in question was buried at an insufficient depth of 8" below finish grade. Please consider this explanation and picture documentation as Beacon Contracting's denial of responsibility for noncompliance. Thank you in advance for your consideration in this important matter.

Good afternoon Ahsan. Thanks for taking the time to talk to me yesterday concerning the damaged gas line at Church of the Harvest on 6/7/23. Please see the attached letter to Leo Haynos on 7/7/23 and a project picture contesting the 6/20/23 KCC Investigation #23-OC-1100.

Our operation that resulted in the damage to the gas line was not an excavation as defined in K.S.A. 66-1802(d) and (e). We were simply setting concrete forms utilizing steel stakes to set our lumber to line and grade. Our operation isn't much different than a surveyor driving a wood hub into the ground with a hammer or a real estate agent putting a for sale sign into a sellers yard. We set thousands of stakes every year on hundreds of projects.

My hope is that you will take a look at this evidence and see that Beacon Contracting was not moving forward in an activity that requires KS One Call locates. Thanks for your consideration.
