STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the State Corporation Commission of the state of Kansas (Commission) files this Recommendation. In support of its Recommendation, Staff states as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On May 29, 2018, IGWT, Inc. (Operator), filed an Application requesting a

location exception and assignment of a full allowable for the Varner Farms #1 well (subject well)

located in Butler County, Kansas.¹

2. On June 11, 2018, the Commission received a protest to the application from

Benjamin Giles.²

3. On July 18, 2018, a procedural schedule was established, setting an evidentiary hearing for October 18, 2018.³

4. On September 27, 2018, due to "significant intervening circumstances," the
Prehearing Officer stayed the procedural schedule and set a Status Conference for October 25, 2018.⁴

5. On October 25, 2018, a Prehearing Officer Order Lifting Stay and Establishing Further Proceedings was issued, scheduling an evidentiary hearing for December 20, 2018.

6. On December 19, 2018, the Protester filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Protest. The Prehearing Officer cancelled the evidentiary hearing based on the Protester's withdrawal of protest.

7. On January 8, 2019, the Commission issued an Order on Withdrawal of Protest; requiring Staff to complete its review of the Operator's Application and provide the Commission with a recommendation regarding approval of the Operator's Application.

II. RECOMMENDATION

8. As stated in Staff witness Jake Eastes' rebuttal testimony, Staff recommends the Commission grant the Operator's Application with a reduced allowable of 55% of the full allowable.⁵

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission grant the Operator's Application with a reduced allowable of 55 barrels of oil per day.


