## ORDER AMENDING VIDEO SERVICE <u>AUTHORIZATION TO INCLUDE OSAGE CITY</u>

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes:

1. On August 25, 2011, MMC Missouri, LLC d/b/a Mediacom (MMC) filed an

Amended Application for state-issued Video Service Authorization, as authorized by K.S.A.

2010 Supp. 12-2023 and K.A.R. 85-15-1 to include within its approved areas the city of Osage

City.

2. MMC was previously granted video service authorizations for the cities of

Eureka, Galena, Scranton, Baldwin City, and Oswego, in an order dated January 20, 2011.

3. Staff filed its Report and Recommendation on September 14, 2011 recommending Commission approval of MMC's Amended Application.

4. Staff stated that MMC properly registered with the FCC for its proposed service areas and provided the following Community Unit Identification (CUID) information:

5. Staff verified the above Community Unit Identification Numbers (CUID) via the FCC's Media Bureau's web site, finds no other deficiencies with MMC's amended application, and recommends Commission approval.

6. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction to consider applications for Video Service Authorization pursuant to K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 12-2023. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission by K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 12-2023, the Commission finds that MMC's Amended Application meets the requirements of the statute and K.A.R. 82-15-1. The Commission approves MMC's Amended Application and designates its footprints as OSAG-06-MMOC-01 (Osage City).

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. MMC's Amended Application for state-issued Video Service Authorization is approved with its service area footprint to be identified as OSAG-06-MMOC-01 (Osage City).

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
