ORDER OPENING DOCKET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 ELECTRIC SUPPLY LINE FILINGS

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On November 15, 2018, in Docket No. 19-GIME-190-CPL, the Commission formalized its practices surrounding Electric Supply Line (EL) requirements contained in K.A.R. 82-12-1 *et seq*. Specifically, the Commission delegated its authority to Staff to approve EL applications during the normal course of business and utilize an annual compliance docket to serve as a repository for such filings and approvals.¹ The Commission also formally adopted Form EL as the Commission-approved form consistent with K.A.R. 82-12-3.²
- 2. The Fiscal Year 2021 annual compliance docket was Docket No. 21-GIME-005-CPL. Consistent with the utilization of annual compliance dockets, this docket is hereby opened for Fiscal Year 2022 (July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022).

3. The most current Form EL was approved by the Commission on June 30, 2020, in Docket No. 21-GIME-005-CPL. An electronic copy of Form EL can be located on the Commission's website.³ A hard-copy is also attached to this Order as Exhibit A.

4. The Commission will retain the same process formalized in Docket No. 19-GIME-190-CPL for Fiscal Year 2022 EL notifications, applications, and approvals.⁴ Entities required by K.A.R. 82-12-1 *et seq.* to file K.A.R. 82-12-3 applications and K.A.R. 82-12-5(a) notices shall do so in the instant docket for Fiscal Year 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. This docket is hereby opened and will serve as the annual compliance docket for Fiscal Year 2022 (July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022) Electric Supply Line (EL) requirements found in K.A.R. 82-12-1 *et seq*. Utilities are directed to utilize the currently approved Form EL and follow the same processes and procedures formalized in Docket No. 19-GIME-190-CPL.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁵
