ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On November 15, 2013, Atmos Energy (Atmos) filed an Application seeking to amend its Purchase Gas Adjustment (PGA) Schedule by adding a Demand Charge Savings and Pipeline Bypass Savings Component to the PGA. Staff met with Atmos and discussed amending the Application.
- 2. On April 24, 2014, Atmos filed an Amended Application, agreeing to waive its two hundred and forty day operation of law date³ until October 14, 2014.⁴
- 3. On May 12, 2014, Commission Staff (Staff) filed its Motion requesting the Commission either set a scheduling conference or issue a procedural schedule.⁵ Staff proposed the following schedule:

Bypass Savings Component to the PGA.
