APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO CEASE SERVICE

Midwest Energy, Inc. ("Midwest" or "Applicant"), hereby requests the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") grant it authorization to cease operating as a natural gas public utility in certain portions of Reno County, Kansas, specifically described as follows:

Northwest Quarter (NW/4) Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

West Half (W/2) Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

Southwest Quarter (SW/4) Section 19, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

> All of Section 12 Township 24 South, Range 5 West

Southeast (SE/4) Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 5 West

East Half (E/2) Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 5 West

Southeast Quarter (SE/4) Section 1, Township 24 South, Range 5 West

All in Reno County, Kansas

In support of its Application, Midwest states:

1. Midwest Energy is a customer-owned Kansas corporation, in good standing, that operates on a not-for-profit cooperative basis. Prior to June 5, 2013, Midwest Energy was a Kansas natural gas public utility regulated under the provisions of K.S.A. 66-104 and 66-1,200 *et seq.* On June 5, 2013, Midwest Energy's natural gas operations were deregulated by the Commission pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 66-104g.

2. Midwest Energy and Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills") have mutually agreed, subject to approval by the Commission, that as a matter of public convenience and necessity to better serve a natural gas customer, Black Hills should serve as the natural gas public utility in the following territory:

Northwest Quarter (NW/4) Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

West Half (W/2) Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

Southwest Quarter (SW/4) Section 19, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

> All of Section 12 Township 24 South, Range 5 West

Southeast (SE/4) Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 5 West

East Half (E/2) Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 5 West

Southeast Quarter (SE/4) Section 1, Township 24 South, Range 5 West

All in Reno County, Kansas

- 3. The territory described is currently within Midwest's service territory. "Exhibit A" provides a map of the territory identifying the areas Midwest Energy will transfer to Black Hills.
- 4. Black Hills will submit a corresponding Application for Certificate of Public Convenience and Authority to Transact the Business of a Natural Gas Public Utility for the territory described in paragraph 2.
- 5. This transfer of territory is pursuant to an agreement between Black Hills and Midwest Energy and will include approximately 18 miles of pipeline. A Memo of Understanding regarding this transfer of territory and assets has been signed and is included as "Exhibit B." The assets would transfer at zero cost to Black Hills. Black Hills would invest approximately \$20,000 on regulating stations at the time of transfer. As part of the proposed transaction, Midwest Energy is transferring 12 customer accounts to Black Hills Energy. A list of those customers is attached to this application as "Exhibit C" and incorporated herein by reference. A copy of this application, along with a comparison of Midwest Energy and Black Hills Energy rates will be mailed to each customer, along with a letter explaining the proposed transaction and informing the customer of the application filed with the Commission and that they can contact Black Hills Energy or the Commission if they have any questions. A sample of that correspondence is attached hereto as "Exhibit D" and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests the Commission authorize Midwest Energy to cease transacting the business of a natural gas public utility in the territory described in paragraph 2 of this Application.





Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Midwest Energy, Inc.
and
Black Hills Energy
Dated May 8, 2015

Midwest Energy, Inc (Midwest) and Black Hills Energy (Black Hills) agree to cooperate in the following manner to allow Midwest Energy customers to be transferred to Black Hills in the area between Haven and Hutchison, Kansas

- Midwest will seek Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) approval to abandon its certificate to provide natural gas service in the territory associated with said customers. Black Hills will file for a certificate to serve the territory concurrent with Midwest's application to cease certification.
- Subject to KCC approval of the certificate transfer, Midwest will install a new plastic pipeline to serve customers shown on Attachment A. Upon project completion, the pipeline and associated facilities will be owned and operated by Black Hills Black Hills will provide Midwest with all needed line markers to be installed by Midwest. The expected date of completion is July 31, 2015, but meeting this target shall not be a requirement of this agreement.
- 3 Black Hills will install a district regulator station at each of two (2) take off points and install its meters and regulators at each customer's tap on the pipeline referenced in Paragraph 2.
- 4. Midwest will secure all permits and Right Of Way necessary for project completion.
- 5. Midwest will seek KCC approval to abandon its certificate to provide natural gas service in Stevens and Seward Counties. Black Hills will file for a certificate to serve the territory concurrent with Midwest's application to cease certification
- The foregoing is conditioned upon the receipt of all regulatory approvals and orders regarding this Memorandum including but not limited to state regulatory agencies in a form and manner satisfactory to each party in its sole discretion.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, this Memorandum is not intended by either of the parties to constitute a definitive agreement with respect to the foregoing nor to give rise to any binding obligations between the parties
