TO: All Oil & Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomsoever concerned.

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that LB Exploration, Inc. has filed an Application with the Kansas Corporation Commission for an exception to the ten (10) year time temporary abandonment limitations of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for its Bloomer B #10 well located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 11 West, Barton County, Kansas.

The Application is pending with the Commission. Any persons who object or protest such Application shall be required to file their objections or complaints in writing with the State Corporation Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this publication. If a written protest is not timely filed with the Commission, the Application may be determined administratively by the Commission and may thereby be granted without hearing or further notice to any interested party. The objection or complaint shall clearly state the reasons why the proposed wellbore, as contained in the Application, will violate correlative rights or cause waste.
