

MOTION TO CLOSE DOCKET

On August 30, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting that an order to show cause be issued against Operator, based upon Commission records indicating unplugged wells remained on Operator's expired license. The matter is currently scheduled for an October 18, 2016, prehearing conference. Operator, however, has recently demonstrated to the satisfaction of Staff that he does not have, and is unlikely to obtain, assets that would make pursuit of this matter worthwhile. Staff believes that it can handle all remaining issues administratively, without the need for a Commission Order against Operator. Therefore, Staff asks that the docket be closed.

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
