ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL AND CLOSING DOCKET

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, the Commission finds and concludes:

- 1. On February 28, 2025, Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. (collectively "Global Crossing") filed an application to cease providing regulated local-exchange and interexchange services.¹
- 2. On May 16, 2025, Global Crossing filed an Application for Withdrawal ("Withdrawal") of its February 28, 2025, filing.² In its withdrawal, Global Crossing notified Staff of its recent 49 C.F.R. 63.71 FCC filing, which stated the company planned to discontinue certain telecommunications services. Global Crossing, in its application, stated it no longer wished to pursue its application filed on February 28, 2025.

3. The Commission finds Global Crossing's withdrawal of its application should be granted and concludes it is reasonable to close the docket.

- A. Global Crossing's Application is hereby withdrawn.
- B. This docket is closed.
- C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).³
