ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO THE CITIZENS' UTILITY RATEPAYER BOARD

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On February 15, 2019, Westar Energy, Inc. and Kansas Gas and Electric Company (Westar) filed to update its Transmission Delivery Charge (TDC) tariff to recover costs associated with Westar's transmission of electric power. The updated TDC filing will shift the allocation of the revenue requirement among the customer classes due to the new 12 CP allocation factors agreed to and approved in the Stipulation and Agreement entered into in Westar's most recent general rate case, Docket No. 18-WSEE-328-RTS.²
- 2. On March 13, 2019, the Citizens' Utility Ratepayers Board (CURB) filed a Petition to Intervene, citing its statutory authority to represent the interests of Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers in any utility proceeding before the Commission under K.S.A. 66-1223, *et*

seq.³ CURB requests permission to intervene as the rates paid by those customers will or may be affected by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding.⁴

3. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in

the interest of justice, if the intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the

proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties and privileges,

immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.⁵ Furthermore,

at any time during a proceeding, the Commission may impose limitations on an intervenor's

participation.⁶

4. The Commission finds and concludes that CURB has met the requirements of

K.A.R. 82-1-225 and K.S.A. 77-521 and should be granted intervention in this Docket. CURB
