ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

1. On January 5, 2017, the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) issued a Penalty Order against NPF Energy Corporation (Operator) alleging three violations of K.A.R. 82-3-603(e) because Operator did not clean up three identified spills in a timely manner on the Brainerd lease, Quinn lease and the Toews A #1 well. The Commission also notes that in KCC Docket 15-CONS-455-CPEN, Operator was penalized for failure to clean up a spill in a timely manner, making the spills in the present matter Operator's second, third and fourth violation of K.A.R. 82-3-603(e) in the last three years.

2. On January 25, 2017, Operator filed a Request for Hearing.

3. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address any matters listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b). The Commission also finds that an initial prehearing conference should be scheduled in this matter.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

B. A Prehearing Conference shall be held on **March 7, 2017 at 1:30 p.m.** by telephone. The conference call information is: telephone number: (866) 620-7326, Conference Code PIN #7632914771.

C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA), K.S.A. 77-501 et seq. Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.

E. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.¹
