PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Prehearing Officer finds the following:

- 1. On October 4, 2018, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Liberty Operations & Completions, Inc. (Operator), concluding the Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-407. On October 18, 2018, Operator requested a hearing.
- 2. On October 25, 2018, the Commission issued an *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a November 16, 2018, prehearing conference, which was subsequently continued as a January 30, 2019, status conference.²
- 3. At the January 30, 2019, status conference, all parties consented to the electronic service of documents.³ Therefore, the Prehearing Officer orders that service of documents may be made by email.
