ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On March 16, 2016, Empire District Electric Company (Empire) and Liberty Sub Corp. (LSC) and Liberty Utilities (Central) Co. (LU Central) (collectively Joint Applicants), filed an application with the Commission for approval of an agreement and plan of merger and for other related relief.
- 2. On March 21, 2016, The Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) filed a Petition to Intervene and Motion for Protective Order and Discovery Order.
- 3. On May 10, 2016, the Commission entered the Order Designating Prehearing Officer; Granting Intervention to CURB; and Protective and Discovery Order.
- 4. On June 1, 2016, the Joint Applicants, Commission Staff and CURB filed a Joint Motion for Procedural Schedule, recommending an agreed schedule to the Commission for its review and approval.

5. Pursuant to the motion with minor modification, the Commission hereby adopts the following procedural schedule:

At the prehearing conference, this proceeding, without further notice, may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of the matter as provided by KAPA.

- The parties are still required to file pleadings with the Commission, and filing 8. shall be made with the Commission's Docket Room before 5:00 p.m., on the date scheduled for service. Any electronic service received after the deadline set forth in the procedural schedule, or any filing made after 5:00 p.m., on the date scheduled for service, shall be accompanied by a Motion to File Out of Time.

- The parties have 15 days from the date this Order was electronically served to В. petition for reconsideration.⁵
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
