Dear Captain Ludolph:

We are in receipt of your initial response to our original rebuttal of the case referenced above, and we don't understand. The law states that any vehicle tagged at 26,000 pounds or under does not require a CDL to operate, yet this was the reason the ticket was written.

Our understanding of the situation when our vehicle was stopped by KHP was that our temporary driver was loaded by a rookie loader at Star Lumber which resulted in more weight being loaded than should have. Beside this fact, to our understanding, the truck still does not require a CDL to operate. While the possibility existed of an overweight ticket being issued, our understanding of the law, the way the vehicle is tagged, a CDL is not required.

We would appreciate you looking this case again, and explaining the necessity of a ticket for not having a CDL.
