**MID-AMERICA PIPELINE COMPANY'S AGREEMENT TO EXTEND OR  
TEMPORARILY WAIVE THE TIME PERIODS PROVIDED FOR UNDER KSA 66-117**


Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC ("MAPL") filed an application with the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission" or "KCC") on July 25, 2011 for the purpose of establishing rates for transportation service in accordance with K.S.A. 66-117, K.S.A. 66-1,217 and K.A.R. 82-10-2. In the application, MAPL included a Motion requesting that the Commission temporarily waive the requirement under KAR 82-10-2 that testimony be filed simultaneously with the application, asking that MAPL be allowed to file such testimony on August 19, 2011. In the application, MAPL confirmed that the time deadlines contained in K.S.A. 66-117 would not begin running until the testimony is filed on August 19, 2011.

2. By the filing of this Notice, MAPL is confirming for the Commission and its Staff that MAPL has agreed to waive the commencement of the 30-day time period and the 240-day time period provided for under KSA 66-117 until August 19, 2011 when its testimony is to be filed. Until that time, the application of MAPL is not considered complete, and MAPL agrees that neither the 30-day period nor the 240-day period provided for under KSA 66-117(c) have begun to run. KSA 66-117(c)(3) allows the public utility and the Commission to agree on a

waiver or extension of the 240-day period, and this Motion is intended to confirm that such agreement has been made by MAPL, as set forth herein.

WHEREFORE, MAPL hereby confirms its agreement under KSA 66-117 that the time periods provided for under KSA 66-117 have been temporarily waived, to the extent required, until MAPL files its testimony in support of its application on August 19, 2011.


