ORDER RESCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 22, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order to Show Cause*, *Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference* (Order), scheduling a Prehearing Conference for September 14, 2017. ¹
- 2. On September 11, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference, stating that, due to a scheduling conflict for the Operator, "[t]he parties jointly request that the pre-hearing conference in this docket, currently scheduled for September 14, 2017, at 1:30 pm be rescheduled to mid-late October 2017."²
- 3. Based on Operator's scheduling conflict, the Commission finds the parties' joint request to reschedule the Prehearing Conference in this matter is reasonable, and therefore, reschedules the Prehearing Conference for 9:30 a.m. on October 26, 2017.

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
