ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being fully advised of all matters of record, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On May 15, 2015, Stephen and Karen Gradwohl filed a Formal Complaint with the Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L).
- 2. KCP&L filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss on June 11, 2015, with an errata being filed June 12, 2015.
 - 3. Staff filed its Report and Recommendation (R&R) on September 28, 2015.
- 4. Pursuant to Kansas Administrative Regulation (K.A.R.) 82-1-218(d), any party may respond within ten (10) days from the date of service of any notice.
- 5. On October 7, 2015, KCP&L requested an extension of time until November 9, 2015 to respond to Staff's R&R, and the Commission granted the extension by Order dated October 13, 2015.
- 6. On November 9, 2015, KCP&L filed a second Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to Staff's R&R, requesting an additional ten days, or until November 19, 2015, to file their response to Staff's R&R. KCP&L stated that additional time was needed due to the

complexity of the issue raised by Staff in the R&R and the additional time needed for research in preparation of their response.

7. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-217(b), the Commission has discretion to grant extensions of time for good cause shown.

This is KCP&L's second request for an extension of time to respond to the Staff's 8. R&R dated September 28, 2015. KCP&L indicates that Staff has no objection to the motion for extension of time.

The Commission finds that under the circumstances described above, the 9. extension should be granted.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

The motion for extension of time for KCP&L to respond to Staff's September 28, A. 2015 Report & Recommendation from November 9, 2015 to November 19, 2015 is granted.

The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the C. purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
