- 1. Applicant is a public utility under the provisions of K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-104.
- The application in this docket was filed with this Commission on December 22,
  A public hearing was neither requested nor held on this application.
- 3. Applicant requests a Certificate to transact the business of an electric public utility in the territory described as follows:

## **COWLEY COUNTY**

Transmission Rights Only

Westar requests transmission rights for a 1 phase, 2 wire, 4.16kV delta overhead primary distribution line beginning at a point near the Northeast corner of Section 30 to the South right of way line of 102nd Road extended; thence Southeast along said South right of way line into Section 29; thence continuing along said South right of way line to a point on the centerline of Section 29; all located in Township 31 South, Range 5 East, Cowley County, Kansas, as shown on Exhibit A, attached to the application.

4. Public convenience will be promoted by permitting Applicant to transact the business of an electric public utility in the territory and to the extent described in Finding No. 3 herein, and the application should be granted for transmission rights only and a Certificate issued

in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-131.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION CONSIDERED AND CERTIFIED:

A. That the application in the instant docket is granted for transmission rights only and

Kansas Gas and Electric Company, doing business as Westar Energy, Inc. is permitted to

transact the business of an electric public utility in the territory and to the extent described in

Finding No. 3 herein.

B. A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15) days from

the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing, and

three (3) days shall be added to the above time frame. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2013

Supp. 77-529.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and parties for the purpose of

entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Kansas Gas and Electric Company, doing business as Westar Energy, Inc. (Westar), filed an Application for Certificate on December 22, 2014, in the above-captioned Docket.

# **ANALYSIS:**

Pursuant to K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-131, the Commission has jurisdiction to grant a certificate to a public utility seeking to transact business in the State of Kansas. K.S.A. 66-1,170 et seq. the Retail Electric Suppliers Act (RESA) requires each and every retail electric supplier to obtain a certificate from the Commission.

The statutory standard of review in this matter is whether the "public convenience will be promoted by the transaction of said business and permitting said applicants to transact the business of a common carrier or public utility in this state." K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-131. Further, single electric certification shall be the standard in Kansas under K.S.A. 66-1,170 et seq.

Westar is requesting this Certificate of Transmission Rights Only along a portion of the route of an electric distribution line being constructed to provide a metering point to Magellan Pipeline. The transmission rights are needed where the proposed line extends through a corridor of electric

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territory certificated to Sumner-Cowley Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Sumner-Cowley). Sumner-Cowley has been provided notice and Staff has received no objection or comment regarding the Application.

The Commission action date is June 20, 2015.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff is recommending that Westar's Application in Docket No. 15-WSEE-266-COC be granted for transmission rights only.
