## RESPONSE TO STAFF'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

The Empire District Electric Company ("Liberty-Empire") submits the following response to the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission") Staff's ("Staff") report and recommendation filed in the above-captioned case on September 3, 2020 ("Staff R&R").

- 1. Liberty-Empire supports the recommendation made in the Staff R&R to use a "stay of enforcement" procedure instead of the "waiver" procedure proposed by Liberty-Empire in the event the COVID-19 pandemic prevents it from being able to comply with the Commission's rules and regulations or the utility's tariff provisions on a temporary basis. Concern over the Commission's oversight and control of the wavier procedure appears to have prompted, at least in part, Staff's recommendation of a stay of enforcement procedure. However, in requesting implementation of a waiver procedure, Liberty-Empire did not intend to eliminate Commission oversight or control of any request made by Liberty-Empire. Even so, the "stay of enforcement" procedure recommended by Staff is acceptable to Liberty-Empire.
- 2. As set forth at page 5 of Staff's R&R, in order for Liberty-Empire to be entitled to a stay of enforcement of any modification to the Commission's rules and regulations or the utility's tariff provisions, Liberty-Empire agrees to submit written notification in this docket of said modification

and the COVID-19 related reasons driving the need for such modification. If Staff or the Commission

disagree with Liberty-Empire's request, then the stay of enforcement is subject to being lifted by the

Commission. The stay of enforcement can also be lifted if the COVID-19 related reasons have been

abated. Staff also recommends that if Staff or the Commission believe the stay of enforcement should

be lifted or if the Commission finds that the COVID-19 reasons have been abated, then Liberty-

Empire should be allowed to request sufficient time to complete the tasks that were delayed as a result

of its request for modification. Staff's recommended procedure is reasonable and is acceptable to

Liberty-Empire.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth herein, Liberty-Empire supports the stay of

enforcement procedure recommended in Staff's R&R.
