PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On January 7, 2020, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Operator, finding various violations of K.A.R. 82-3-603 for failure to report and clean up spills on the Wright lease.¹
 - 2. On January 27, 2020, Operator requested a hearing.²
- 3. On February 4, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, setting a February 18, 2020, prehearing conference.³
- 4. On February 18, 2020, Commission Staff attended the prehearing conference, but Operator did not.⁴ The same day, Staff filed a motion for a default order against Operator.
- 5. On February 24, 2020, Staff withdrew its request for a default order, instead requesting that a prehearing conference be scheduled.⁵ Staff alluded to service issues with the Commission's February 4, 2020, order.⁶

this, the Prehearing Officer finds it appropriate to reschedule the prehearing conference.
