# **SUSPENSION ORDER: JANUARY 23, 2026**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration. Having reviewed and being advised in the matter, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:

- 1. On May 28, 2025, Jayhawk Pipeline, LLC submitted its application requesting approval of tariff revisions based on the FERC Index for 2025. 1
  - 2. K.S.A. 66-117(c) states in part:

The commission shall not delay the effective date of the proposed change in rate, joint rate, toll, charge or classification or schedule of charges, or in any rule or regulation or practice pertaining to the service or rates of any such public utility or common carrier, more than 240 days beyond the date the public utility or common carrier filed its application requesting the proposed change. If the commission does not suspend the proposed schedule within 30 days of the date the same is filed by the public utility or common carrier, such proposed schedule shall be deemed approved by the commission and shall take effect on the proposed effective date.

- 3. A full investigation of the application is found to be necessary and proper. Without suspension, the Commission and its Staff lack sufficient time to fully review and consider whether approval of the application will result in just and reasonable rates.
- 4. Suspension of the application's effective date is required to allow sufficient time for a full investigation of this matter.

## THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c), the application in the above-captioned docket, and the effective date therein, shall be suspended 240 days, until Friday January 23, 2026, subject to further action by the Commission.
  - B. Electronic service shall be utilized for serving pleading/motions and orders.
- C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).<sup>2</sup>
