## ORDER ASSESSING CURB COSTS PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 66-1503

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes the following:

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1503(b), the Commission shall assess against all public utilities and common carriers subject to Commission jurisdiction an amount equal to the total amount of the expenditures for the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) for the preceding quarter year, calculated pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1503(a).
- 2. For CURB expenditures, all public utilities and common carriers should be individually assessed an amount not to exceed the greater of \$25.00 (\$100 annually) or 0.2% of its respective gross operating revenue derived from intrastate operations as reflected in the last annual report filed with the Commission before the fiscal year began.<sup>1</sup>
  - 3. K.S.A. 66-1504 shall govern any default in payment of the quarterly assessment.

4. Any public utility or common carrier assessed pursuant to this Order is hereby notified that it has the right to file with the Commission objections setting out in detail the ground upon which such assessment is regarded to be excessive, erroneous, unlawful or invalid.<sup>2</sup> Hearings regarding such objections shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas administrative procedure act.<sup>3</sup>

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

A. All public utilities and common carriers are assessed and ordered to pay their respective amount to the Commission regarding the assessment for expenses of the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice of assessment.<sup>4</sup>

**Dear Commissioners:** 

I, Shonda Rabb, hereby certify that the amount of expenditures of the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) to be assessed against all public utilities and common carriers pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1503(a) for the 3rd Quarter of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, is \$138,000.
