ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On May 24, 2019, BlueRidge Petroleum Corporation (Operator) submitted an Application seeking an exception to the pit closure time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-602.¹
2. On July 25, 2019, the Commission issued an order granting Operator's Application, giving Operator 45 days from the date of the Order to close the subject pit.²
3. On October 17, 2019, Operator filed a motion for an extension of time to close the subject pits.³
4. On January 3, 2020, Operator filed a request to withdraw its motion for an extension of time. The request stated Operator successfully closed the subject pit on December 16, 2019.⁴
5. In light of Operator's request to withdraw its Application, the Commission finds further proceedings are unnecessary, and this docket should be closed.


THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:
