As a small business just trying to figure out what needs to be completed we contacted the KCC several times. We requested a booklet on how, what, and when to file for new leases. We never received one. When filing the ACO-1 we contacted the KCC at least 5 times to get help filing it.

Our letter dated 3-12-15 it stated the ACO-1 needed to be filed by 3-26-15 we sent the ACO-1 by mail on 3-18-15 the KCC received it on 3-24-15. The reason it was mailed in was because on the Kolar website it said to print it, so we took it that it was to be mailed. Our secretary was out of state from the 3-19-15 until 4-1-15, when she returned she had checked her e-mails and found out the ACO-1 had to be filed on line, therefore was incomplete. We then sent it online thru Kolar on 4-2-15. On 4-3-15 we received an email stating it was incomplete once again, and had 30 days to complete the form. When our secretary sent the ACO-1 on 4-2-15 she did not check the resubmit box needed to complete. On 4-20-15 she spoke with Naomi James and she told her that she needed to check the box then it would be accepted.

As you can see we tried several times to send a completed form. We feel that the penalty is unjustified, we understand that some companies may use the system that was not our intensions. We would like to have this case reviewed and request a hearing.
