This is a notice of a penalty assessment against American Logistics LLC (American Logistics) for violations of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted from July 25 to July 30, 2024, by a Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 27, 2024. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY: American Logistics has been assessed a \$1,400 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$1,400, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of American Logistics to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety meetings.htm.

IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing. A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. American Logistics must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.\frac{1}{2}

<u>IF YOU FAIL TO ACT:</u> Failure to pay the penalty of \$1,400 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. From July 25 to July 30, 2024, a Commission Staff ("Staff") Special Investigator ("SI") completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of American Logistics LLC (American Logistics or Carrier). American Logistics is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, and operates under USDOT number 3475280.
- 2. On July 31, 2024, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation ("R&R"), attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$1,400 to be issued to American Logistics based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered. Staff's R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigation, the SI identified three (3) violation(s), accounting for three (3)

count(s), of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.²

- 3. Additionally, Staff recommends that American Logistics be required to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.³ A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety meetings.htm.
- 4. Staff further recommends American Logistics submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.⁴
- 5. Finally, Staff recommends that American Logistics submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.⁵ Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, and 66-1,114, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in

Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.

- 7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.
- 8. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. American Logistics is hereby assessed a \$1,400 civil penalty for three (3) violation(s), accounting for three (3) count(s), of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.
- B. American Logistics is hereby ordered to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.
- C. American Logistics is hereby ordered to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and

detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

D. American Logistics is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.

E. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of American Logistics' right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.

F. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest.⁶ For civil penalties of \$500 or less, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation.⁷

G. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$1,400 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$1,400 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

H. Failure to pay the \$1,400 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in suspension of American Logistics' motor carrier operating authority without further notice. Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

of Motor Carrier Authority

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Amercian Logistics LLC is a motor carrier (MC) possessing public for-hire operating authority from the Commission, primarily hauling general freight and intermodal containers. Amercian Logistics LLC operates under USDOT 3475280. From July 25 to July 30, 2024, a Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Amercian Logistics LLC. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified three (3) violations, accounting for three (3) specific counts, of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, staff recommends penalty of \$1,400 be issued to the MC.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:

On July 31, 2024, an SI conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Amercian Logistics LLC. The investigation covers a 365 day period and any previous compliance review. Each specific count is detailed below.

Count One (1 of 3)

<u>Juris diction:</u> 49 C.F.R. 382.301(a), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

<u>Intent of Law:</u> The MC must require its driver to submit to a pre-employment controlled substances USDOT regulated test and to obtain a negative test result prior to requiring or permitting the driver to operate a commercial motor vehicle.

Supporting Documentation: On June 10, 2024, American Logistics LLC required or permitted its driver, Jose Salazar, to operate a commercial driver's license (CDL) required commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 2014 Volvo truck, VIN ending in 8088, GVWR 50,350 lbs., in interstate commerce from Raytown, Missouri to Lowell, Arkansas. This transport is evidenced by a Driver's Daily Log, dated June 10, 2024, attached hereto as Exhibit 2. Additionally, an emailed interchange receipt is attached hereto as Exhibit 3. Finally, a Driver/Vehicle Examination Report No. KSHP00180345, dated June 10, 2024, is attached hereto as Exhibit 4. The MC was unable to provide the SI with a negative test result for this driver obtained prior to the date of this transport. Violation: The MC failed to require its driver to submit to a pre-employment-controlled substances USDOT regulated test and to obtain a negative test result prior to requiring or permitting the driver to operate a commercial motor vehicle (Exhibit 1, Page 3). One (1) violation was discovered.

Recommendations: Staff recommends a fine of \$650.

Count Two (2 of 3)

<u>Juris diction:</u> 49 C.F.R. 382.701(a), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1.129.

<u>Intent of Law:</u> The MC must conduct a pre-employment inquiry into its drivers with the FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse (DACH).

<u>Supporting Documentation:</u> The violation took place during the transport described in Count One, above. The MC's DACH query history is attached as **Exhibit 5**. There is no record of a preemployment inquiry into driver Jose Salazar on the query history.

<u>Violation:</u> The MC failed to conduct a pre-employment query into its drivers with the FMCSA DACH (Exhibit 1, Page 3). One (1) violation was discovered.

Recommendations: Staff recommends a fine of \$500.

Count Three (3 of 3)

<u>Juris diction</u>: 49 C.F.R. 395.8, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3a, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129. <u>Intent of Law</u>: The MC shall require its driver to keep records of duty status for each 24-hour period using the method described in 49 C.F.R. 395.8(a) and to submit the original record to the motor carrier within 13 days of creation.

<u>Supporting Documentation:</u> The violation took place during the transport described in Count One, above. Driver Jose Salazar's did not fill out an adequate driver's log for June 10, 2024. The interexchange receipt states Mr. Salazar picked up a load in Lowell, Arkansas, which is beyond 150 air miles and therefore the transport was required to be logged. The Driver's Daily Log (Exhibit 2) only lists travel within the Kansas City area.

<u>Violation:</u> The MC failed to require its driver to keep records of duty status for each 24-hour period using the method described in 49 C.F.R. 395.8(a) and to submit the original record to the motor carrier within 13 days of creation (**Exhibit 1**, **Page 3 to 4**). One (1) violation was discovered. **Recommendations:** Staff recommends a fine of \$250.

RECOMMENDATION:


Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find Amercian Logistics LLC committed three (3) violations, accounting for three (3) specific counts, of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$1,400 for three (3) violations of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends Amercian Logistics LLC require a representative responsible for the company's safety to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety meetings.htm.

Staff further recommends Amercian Logistics LLC submit a written, comprehensive Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violations described in the Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining the carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violations do not occur in the future.

Finally, Staff recommends that Amercian Logistics LLC submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.

On 6/10/2024 Jose Salazar drove from Raytown, MO to Lowell, AR. The ELD indicated driving within 150 air miles from his original destination. The trip exceeds the 150 air mile radius, but less than 50 miles.

Specific Recommended Remedies

To implement Safety Improvement Practices, the following list are recommended practices related to Monitoring and Tracking:

1. Promptly review all Records of Duty Status (RODS) for Hours-of-Service (HOS) violations and falsification. Look for discrepancies by comparing driver logs with their "check-in" calls and other supporting documents.

BASIC: Controlled Substances/Alcohol Process Breakdown: Monitoring and Tracking

Jose Salazar had a hire date of 4/26/2024. A pre-employment query was not conducted on him.

Specific Recommended Remedies

To implement Safety Improvement Practices, the following list are recommended practices related to Monitoring and Tracking:

1. Ensure that all test records are monitored for adherence to retention dates and nondisclosure requirements.

6. Clearinghouse Pre-employment Query

Ensure pre-employment (full) queries are conducted in the Clearinghouse before hiring a driver to perform a safety sensitive function.

7. Require drivers to prepare complete and accurate records.

Require all drivers to prepare complete and accurate records of duty status for each day, and to submit them within 13 days. Maintain all duty status records on file, with all supporting documents, for at least 6 months.

8. Serious Violations

This review contains violations that are serious in nature and may result in a penalty assessment against the company and/or drivers.

9. CAP to Commission

The KCC requires that you prepare a corrective action plan, addressing the measures taken to correct all the violations identified within this report. Submit this letter within 30 days outlining the carrier's updated changes to their policies and procedures regarding all listed violations.
