ORDER AMENDING VIDEO SERVICE AUTHORIZATION TO INCLUDE THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and record, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On September 6, 2013, MMC Missouri LLC d/b/a Mediacom (MMC) filed an Amended Application for its state-issued Video Service Authorization, as authorized by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-2023(a) and K.A.R. 82-15-1, to include within its approved areas, the City of Burlingame, Kansas.
- 2. MMC was previously granted video service authorization in ten (10) communities in Kansas pursuant to Commission Orders issued in this docket on January 20, 2011, September 22, 2011, October 13, 2011, March 13, 2012, and October 8, 2012.
- 3. On September 25, 2013, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation dated September 25, 2013, recommending Commission approval of MMC's Amended Application.
- 4. Staff states that MMC is a foreign limited liability company properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office and that the company's status with that office is "active and in good standing". Staff further states that MMC is registered with the Federal

Communications Commission (FCC) as a Cable System Operator under the following Community Unit Identification Number (CUID):

By initialing, MMC in its initial filing in this docket on December 30, 2010, agreed to comply with all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations and agrees to comply with all lawful and applicable municipal regulations regarding the use and occupation of public rights-of-way in the delivery of video services, including the police powers of the municipalities in which the service is delivered. - 6. MMC seeks additional authority in Burlingame and has provided the following description:

MMC has provided the foregoing description in an electronic format, compatible with the Commission's mapping system. MMC has provided a high-level drawing of its hybrid fiber/coax network configured in a ring and spoke configuration. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On September 6, 2013, MMC Missouri LLC d/b/a Mediacom (MMC) filed an Amended Application for its state-issued Video Service Authorization, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-2023 and K.A.R. 82-15-1.

In accordance with K.S.A. 12-2023(a), Commission action in this matter is required not later than **Sunday, October 6, 2013**.

BACKGROUND:

The Applicant has previously been granted video service authorizations in ten communities in Kansas. This amended filing seeks to expand previously granted authority to include the city of Burlingame, Kansas.

ANALYSIS:

The Applicant has reaffirmed its principal place of business as 100 Crystal Run Road, Middletown, N.Y., 10941, and has previously provided its officers and contact personnel¹.

The Applicant is registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office as a Foreign Limited Liability Company and is currently 'Active and in Good Standing' with the Secretary's office.

The Applicant is registered with the FCC as a Cable System Operator, as follows:

The Applicant states that it is the incumbent provider and currently passes 100% of the households.

The Applicant has provided a high level drawing of its hybrid fiber/coax network configured in a ring and spoke configuration.

^{2.} For ease of future referencing, staff assigns a four field footprint number using the following convention: ABCD-xx-EFGH-yy, where ABCD is the four character abbreviation of the major city encompassed by the service area, xx is a two digit sequentially assigned number of the provider's service areas, EFGH is the four alpha character company code and yy indicating the version of the company's footprint where 01 is the initial version, 02 the first revision, etc.
