This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Pablo Becerril-Loma d/b/a Becerril Trucking (Becerril Trucking) for violations of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted May 29, 2024, by a Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 29, 2023. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

**IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY:** Becerril Trucking has been assessed a \$150 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$150, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) systemlocated at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of Becerril Trucking to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website <a href="http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety\_meetings.htm">http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety\_meetings.htm</a>.

**IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing.** A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Becerril Trucking must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.<sup>1</sup>

**IF YOU FAIL TO ACT:** Failure to pay the penalty of \$150 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

#### PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On May 29, 2024, a Commission Staff ("Staff") Special Investigator ("SI") completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Pablo Becerril-Loma, d/b/a Becerril Trucking, of (Becerril Trucking or Carrier). Becerril Trucking is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, and operates under USDOT number 2888453.

2. On May 30, 2024, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation ("R&R"), attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$150 to be issued to Becerril Trucking based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered. Staff's R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigation, the SI identified two (2) violations, accounting for one (1) count, of the Motor

Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.<sup>2</sup>

3. Additionally, Staff recommends that Becerril Trucking be required to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.<sup>3</sup> A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety meetings.htm.

4. Staff further recommends Becerril Trucking submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.<sup>4</sup>

5. Finally, Staff recommends that Becerril Trucking submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.<sup>5</sup> Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

6. Pursuant to K.S.A 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, and 66-1,114b, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or

procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.

7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.

8. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

#### IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Becerril Trucking is hereby assessed a \$150 civil penalty for two (2) violations, accounting for one (1) count, of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.

B. Becerril Trucking is hereby ordered to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.

C. Becerril Trucking is hereby ordered to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed

information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

D. Becerril Trucking is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.

E. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Becerril Trucking's right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.

F. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest.<sup>6</sup> For civil penalties of \$500 or less, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation.<sup>7</sup>

G. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$150 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$150 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at <u>https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/</u>. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

H. Failure to pay the \$150 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in suspension of Becerril Trucking's motor carrier operating authority without further notice.<sup>8</sup> Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Pablo Becerril-Loma d/b/a Becerril Trucking (Pablo Becerril-Loma) is a motor carrier (MC) possessing public for-hire operating authority from the Commission, primarily hauling grain, feed, and hay. Pablo Becerril-Loma operates under USDOT 2888453. On May 29, 2024, a Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Pablo Becerril-Loma. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified two (2) violations, accounting for one (1) specific count, of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, staff recommends penalty of \$150 be issued to the MC.

#### **DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:**

On May 29, 2024, a Commission Staff SI conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Pablo Becerril-Loma. The investigation covers a 365 day period and any previous compliance review. Each specific count is detailed below.

#### Count One (1 of 1)

Jurisdiction: 49 C.F.R. 382.701(b), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

Intent of Law: The MC must conduct an annual inquiry into its drivers with the FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse (DACH).

**Supporting Documents**: On September 25, 2023, Pablo Becerril-Loma, required or permitted its driver, Pablo Becerril-Ramirez, to operate a commercial driver's license (CDL) required commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 1993 Freightliner, VIN ending in 4189,GVWR 52,000 lbs., pulling a 1995 Wilson semi-trailer, VIN ending in 1270, GVWR 65,000 lbs., in intrastate commerce from Ford, Kansas to Wichita, Kansas. This transport is evidenced by Driver/Vehicle Examination Report No. KSHP01893112, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, the carrier's pre-employment DACH query record, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and the carrier's annual DACH query record, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and the carrier's annual DACH query record, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**. An annual query was required to be conducted by February 23, 2023. The MC did not complete an annual query on Mr. Becceril-Ramirez until November 3, 2023 (*See* Exhibit 4), two months after this transport. **Violation**: Pablo Becerril-Loma failed to conduct annual inquiries into its drivers with the FMCSA

<u>Violation</u>: Pablo Becerril-Loma failed to conduct annual inquiries into its drivers with the FMCSA DACH (Exhibit 1, Page 3). Two (2) violations were discovered.

**Recommendation**: Staff recommends a fine of \$150.

#### **<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**:

Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find Pablo Becerril-Loma committed two (2) violations, accounting for one (1) specific count, of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$150 for two (2) violations of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends Pablo Becerril-Loma require a representative responsible for the company's safety to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at <a href="http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety\_meetings.htm">http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety\_meetings.htm</a>.

Staff further recommends Pablo Becerril-Loma submit a written, comprehensive Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation described in the Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining the carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation does not occur in the future.

Finally, Staff recommends that Pablo Becerril-Loma submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.
