## ORDER RESCINDING ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR LICENSE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

#### I. JURISDICTION

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155, the Commission is authorized to license operators and contractors as defined by K.S.A. 55-150.
- 2. K.S.A. 55-155 and K.A.R. 82-3-120 outline requirements of the applicant seeking a license or renewed license.

#### II. BACKGROUND

- 3. On August 1, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Denying Application for License in this docket. The Order found Operator's Application failed to meet the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155 and K.A.R. 82-3-120.
  - 4. On August 14, 2017, Operator requested a hearing.
- On August 29, 2017, the Commission issued an Order setting a September 14,
   2017, prehearing conference. On September 19, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Setting
   Procedural Schedule.

6. On October 9, 2017, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Rescind Order Denying Application for License. Staff stated that additional information has been received and Operator's Application now meets the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155 and K.A.R. 82-3-120.

#### III. FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- The Commission finds Staff's Motion to Rescind Order Denying Application for License is reasonable and should be granted. The Commission concludes that the August 1,
   2017, Order Denying Application for License in this docket should be rescinded.
- 8. The procedural schedule and December 14, 2017, evidentiary hearing in this docket is cancelled.

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. The Order Denying Application for License that was issued in this docket is rescinded.
- B. Parties have 15 days from the date of service of this order to petition the Commission for reconsideration.<sup>1</sup>
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
