ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On November 6, 2017, American Warrior, Inc. (Applicant) filed an Application for Injection Well to authorize injection of saltwater into the Morrow Foundation at the Blaesi #10-6 well, located in Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 14 West, Wallace County, Kansas.
2. On November 30, 2017, Quinque Operating Company (Protestant) filed a protest to the Application.
3. On February 28, 2018, the Protestant filed a Withdrawal of Protest.
4. There are no other protests of record in this matter. As such, Staff is directed to process the application accordingly and advise the Commission if a hearing is necessary. Otherwise, the Docket shall be closed.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Staff shall process the Application administratively. If Staff does not recommend denial of the Application, this docket shall be closed.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
