ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On November 6, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$1,000 for failure to timely submit complete, accurate well completion reports and associated documents (“ACO-1’s”) for the Kirk Jones #3 and Kirk Jones #4-14.
2. Staff reports that Operator did not timely file ACO-1’s for the wells, and that the deadline in the Notice of Violation letter had passed by the time completed ACO-1’s were received by Staff. However, when Staff received the completed ACO-1’s, only hours had passed since the deadline in the Notice of Violation letter. If Staff had recognized this, then Staff would not have recommended a penalty in this docket.
3. Based upon the above, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the November 6, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


A. The Penalty Order issued in this docket is rescinded.
