

This section includes all charges for telecommunications service provided by the Company, other than those charges covered under a special contract between a subscriber and the Company. In addition the Company will add applicable federal excise, franchise and sales taxes to each monthly bill as a separate charge.

3.2 Local Exchange Telephone Service

These rates apply to all subscribers of the Telephone Company. This rate only covers the provision of network access to a local customer location.

The rate quoted in this Tariff for local exchange service entitles the customer to local calls (without toll charge) to all local stations served by central offices of the extended local service area where comprised of more than one exchange.

3.21 Basic Service Rates

These rates apply to all subscribers of all exchanges of the Company, per line:
