CERTIFICATE

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes on for consideration and determination by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On May 24, 2013 Butler Rural Electric Cooperative Association, Inc. ("Applicant") filed an application seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide electric service to a portion of Butler County, Kansas as required by K.S.A. 66-131. Applicant is an electric public utility as defined by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 66-104. A public hearing was not held on the instant application.
- 2. Specifically, Applicant requests a Certificate in the territory described as follows: BUTLER COUNTY

A tract of land described as the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 12, Township 25S, Range 4E, as detailed in maps attached to the application.

3. The territory described in paragraph 2 above is currently served by Kansas Gas and Electric Company dba Westar Energy. Pursuant to Docket No. 14-KG&E-001-CCS, Kansas

Gas and Electric Company dba Westar Energy requests permission to cease operating as an electric public utility in that territory.

4. Public convenience will be promoted by allowing Applicant to provide electric service in the territory described in paragraph 2 above. The application, therefore, should be granted and a Certificate issued to Applicant in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 66-131.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION CONSIDERED AND CERTIFIED:

A. The application filed herein is granted and Butler Rural Electric Cooperative Association, Inc. is permitted to transact the business of an electric public utility in the territory described in Finding No. 2 herein.

B. A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing, and three (3) days shall be added to the above time frame. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 77-529.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.

BACKGROUND:

Butler Rural Electric Cooperative Association, Inc. (Butler Rural) filed an Application for Certificate in Docket No. 13-BTRE-750-COC on May 24, 2013. Kansas Gas and Electric Company dba Westar Energy (Westar) filed a companion Cease Operation Application on July 1, 2013, in Docket No. 14-KG&E-001-CCS. On July 12, 2013, Westar filed an Amended Application.

ANALYSIS:

There are no customers currently being served by Westar in the small tract of electric territory being exchanged in these Applications. A new customer plans to build a residence and barn in the area being exchanged. Butler Rural has an existing service line immediately adjacent to the new customer's property. Westar's closest distribution line is approximately one-half mile away. This territory exchange will permit Butler Rural to more efficiently provide electric service to this new customer.

The Commission action date is November 20, 2013.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff is recommending that the Application for Certificate in 13-BTRE-750-COC and the Amended Cease Operation Application in 14-KG&E-001-CCS be granted.
