**ERRATA SUBSTITUTION TO
THE DIRECT TESTIMONY OF LINDA H. BLAIR**

On May 10, 2016, in the above captioned docket, ITC Great Plains, LLC, on behalf of itself and its parent company ITC Holdings Corp., together with Fortis Inc. and its subsidiaries, including FortisUS Inc., ITC Investment Holdings Inc. and Element Acquisition Sub Inc. (collectively, "Joint Applicants"), jointly submitted an application ("Application") pursuant to K.S.A. §§ 66-101, 66-104, 66-131, 66-136, and 66-1401 *et seq.*, requesting approval by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas of a transaction involving an upstream change in ownership of ITC Great Plains, LLC. The Application included the Direct Testimony of Linda H. Blair ("Blair Testimony"). Subsequent to filing, Joint Applicants discovered that an incomplete version of the Blair Testimony was inadvertently included with the Application. Joint Applicants hereby submit a revised version of the Blair Testimony as a complete substitute for the originally filed version.

The revised version of the Blair Testimony includes a more comprehensive answer to the following question: "Are there operational synergies that will result from the Transaction (Merger Standards Order (a)(iv))?" The revised answer to that question appears on pages 9-10

of the revised version of the Blair Testimony. All other revisions are minor and non-substantive. None of the revisions materially change the Application and will not cause any prejudice to any party at this early stage of the proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Joint Applicants respectfully submit the Errata Substitution to the Direct Testimony of Linda H. Blair.


