**ORDER**

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1.        On July 3, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") filed an application for approval of a modification to the interconnection agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Kansas and Logix Communications, LP d/b/a Logix Communications ("Logix"). This modification to the agreement is consistent with the provisions of Section 252(e) of the Federal Act and amends the agreement previously negotiated, executed, and filed with the Commission on May 2, 2006.

2.        The modification amends the agreement to extend the original expiration date of December 12, 2008, to December 12, 2011.

3.        In a memo dated August 20, 2007, Commission Staff ("Staff") stated that it has reviewed the modification and finds no evidence to conclude that the agreement discriminates against any telecommunications carrier, nor is inconsistent with public interest, convenience and necessity.

4. Staff reports that Logix is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office and has a status of "active and in good standing."

5. The Commission finds and concludes that the modification to the previously approved interconnection agreement between SWBT and Logix should be granted. The implementation of this modification is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not, on its face, discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. The July 3, 2007 application of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for approval of a modification to the interconnection agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Kansas and Logix Communications, LP d/b/a Logix Communications is hereby approved.

B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118; K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.

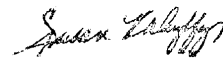
