MOTION TO SUSPEND INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission suspend American Logistics LLC of Leawood, Kansas (Carrier) from all intrastate commercial motor carrier operations. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112 and 66-1,114b, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 40 C.F.R. 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority, and jurisdiction.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130, and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke, or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision, or regulation of the Commission.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,105, "[e]very order and decision of the commission on matters covered by this act shall become operative and effective within 30 days after service, and

the motor carrier shall carry the provisions of the order into effect, unless the order is enjoined or set aside by a court of proper jurisdiction."

Carrier is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5, as adopted by K.A.R.
82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.

5. Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT number 3475280. Carrier's USDOT Profile was updated on March 1, 2024, by the filing of an MCS-150 form that lists its current physical and mailing address, phone number and email address. A copy of Carrier's MCS-150 form is attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference.

6. On August 8, 2024, the Commission issued Carrier a Penalty Order that assessed a civil penalty of \$1,400 for violations of the Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted by a Staff Special Investigator from July 25 through 30, 2024. In the Penalty Order, the Carrier was ordered to pay the \$1,400 civil penalty within thirty (30) days of service, to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days of the date of the Penalty Order, and to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of the Penalty Order.

7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,105, the Carrier was sent the Penalty Order via U.S. certified mail, return receipt requested, on August 8, 2024. According to Legal Staff, the Penalty Order was returned as undelivered on October 29, 2024. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-613, the Penalty Order was deposited in U.S. mail to the same address on October 29, 2024. The second attempt at service as not returned. An affidavit of Ann Murphy, Administrative Assistant for Legal Staff is attached hereto as Attachment "B." *See also* K.A.R. 82-1-216.

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8. K.S.A. 66-1,105 states that "orders and decisions potentially resulting in in a negative impact upon any motor carrier's authority...shall be served by certified mail, retum receipt requested." Staff sent the Penalty Order to Carrier at its last known address by certified mail, return receipt requested. The Kansas Administrative Procedures Act at K.S.A. 77-613 states that service shall be made by "mailing a copy of it to them at their last known addresses" and further that "service by mail is complete upon mailing." Staff also sent the Penalty Order by U.S. first class mail on October 29, 2024. "When a court is presented with a general statute and a specific statute governing the same circumstances, the court should attempt to read the statutes together in harmony with one another. If the statutes cannot be read in harmony, the specific statute will generally control over the general statute, unless a contrary intent is clearly expressed by the legislature." *See In re Guardianship of Sokol*, 40 Kan. App. 2d 57, 63, 189 P.3d 526, 531 (2008).

9. The Carrier had 30 days from the date served, October 29, 2024, to pay the civil penalty of \$300.

10. Carrier was sent a collection letter to the mailing address listed on its MCS-150 form on November 20,2024, reminding it of the amount due and giving it 10 days from the date of the collection letter to pay. A copy of the collection letter is attached hereto as Attachment "C" and is hereby incorporated by reference.

11. As of January 30, 2025, Commission records indicate that Carrier has not complied with the collection letter or the requirements of the Penalty Order.

12. Staff requests the Commission find that Carrier received sufficient notice of the requirement to comply with the Penalty Order issued August 8, 2024, including written notice by the collection letter sent November 20, 2024.

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13. Staff asks that the Commission find the Carrier failed to respond and has not complied with the Commission's Penalty Order, which is a violation of K.S.A. 66-1,105 and 66-1,142b.

14. Based on the presented facts, Staff requests the Commission issue an order suspending Carrier's intrastate motor carrier operations until such time as Carrier pays the penalty of \$1,400, require the Carrier to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar and submit a CAP that meets the approval of Transportation Staff, at which time Staff will recommend the Commission enter an order of reinstatement of intrastate motor carrier operations.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order suspending Carrier's intrastate motor carrier.

On 8/8/2024, a Penalty Order was issued against American Logistics LLC for violations of motor carrier safety statutes, rules and regulations.
