ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE WITH MODIFICATION

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On May 1, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an Application with supporting documents and testimony requesting authorization from the Commission to make certain changes in its charges for electric services in Kansas and for approval of other requests set forth in the Application.

2. On May 3, 2018, the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) filed a Petition for Intervention.

3. On May 10, 2018, the Commission issued the Suspension Order suspending action on the application for a period of 240 days from filing, December 27, 2018.¹

4. On May 15, 2018, the Commission granted CURB intervention and issued Discovery and Protective Orders.

5. On June 5, 2018, Walmart Stores, Inc. (Walmart) filed a Petition to Intervene.

6. On June 5, 2018, Midwest Division – OPRMC, LLC d/b/a Overland Park Regional Medical Center (OPRMC) filed a Petition to Intervene.

7. On June 13, 2018, Kansas Gas Service, a division of ONE Gas, Inc. (KGS) filed a Petition for Intervention.

8. On June 26, 2018, the Parties filed a Joint Motion for Procedural Schedule.

9. On June 28, 2018, the Commission granted intervention to Walmart and OPRMC.

10. On July 12, 2018, the Commission granted intervention to KGS.

11. The Commission finds that the Joint Motion for Procedural Schedule should be granted with two modifications. First, the Commission sets the Public Hearing for August 23, 2018, at Kansas University Edwards Campus, Best Conference Center, 12600 Quivira Road, Overland Park, Kansas, 66213. Second, the Commission will convene the Evidentiary Hearing on Tuesday, October 23, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commission's Topeka Office, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas, 66604.

12. Therefore, the procedural schedule shall be as follows:

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


- A. The procedural schedule outlined in paragraph 12 above is adopted.
