STAFF'S MOTION TO WAIVE CIVIL FINE

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its Motion requesting the Commission waive the civil fine in Penalty Order issued to Concrete Service Co Inc (Carrier). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
2. Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 977271.
3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,139a and K.A.R. 82-4-30a, motor carriers operating interstate commerce must pay Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees annually, by January 1, 2025. Carrier failed to pay its annual UCR fees by January 1, 2025, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a.
4. On July 8, 2025, the Commission issued Carrier a Penalty Order.¹ The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$700 civil fine for failing to pay its 2025 UCR fees by January 1, 2025, as

required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.

5. On July 9, 2024, Carrier contacted Staff regarding the Penalty Order and Carrier's unpaid UCR fees. Carrier stated that it does not operate in interstate commerce and requested Staff update its USDOT profile accordingly.

6. Staff, after a review of records, could not find evidence the Carrier had operated in interstate commerce. Staff updated the Carrier's USDOT profile to show that it only operates in intrastate commerce.

7. Based on the information provided, Staff asks the Commission to waive the \$700 civil fine ordered on July 8, 2025, Penalty Order.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order waiving the \$700 civil fine in the Penalty Order issued July 8, 2025.
