**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CONTINUING STATUS CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On July 25, 2017, the Commission designated a Prehearing Officer to address any scheduling or procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b).<sup>1</sup>
2. On November 3, 2017, at the scheduled Status Conference, the parties agreed to continue the Status Conference until January 5, 2018 at 10:45 a.m., in the hopes of resolving the outstanding issues involved in this proceeding.

**THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:**

- A. The Status Conference shall be continued to **Friday, January 5, 2018, at 10:45 a.m.** by telephone. The conference call information is: telephone number: (866) 620-7326, Conference Code PIN: 7632914771#.
- B. At the Status Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

C. At the Status Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA).<sup>2</sup> Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Status Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to the KAPA.<sup>3</sup>

D. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.<sup>4</sup>

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for reconsideration.<sup>5</sup>

F. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
