

5. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

6. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.¹

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 2 is adopted.


B. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for reconsideration.²

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
