This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On October 21, 2016, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for an Order to Show Cause, the Designating of a Prehearing Officer, and the Scheduling of a Prehearing Conference.

2. On January 19, 2017, the Commission issued the Order to Show Cause, Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Officer. The Commission set a prehearing conference for February 7, 2017 at 1:30 p.m.¹
