STAFF'S MOTION TO REINSTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS AND WAIVE CIVIL FINE

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its Motion requesting the Commission reinstate the Kansas motor carrier operations as well as waive the civil fine in Penalty Order issued to Ed Thompson Trucking LLC Operating (Carrier). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
- Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation
 (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 3653168.
- 3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,139a and K.A.R. 82-4-30a, motor carriers operating interstate commerce must pay Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees annually, by January 1, 2025. Carrier failed to pay its annual UCR fees by January 1, 2025, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a.
- 4. On October 16, 2025, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations,¹ due to non-compliance with a Penalty Order issued in this docket on August 5, 2025.² The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$300 civil fine for its failure to pay its 2025 UCR

fees by January 1, 2025, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367-40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.

- 5. On October 27, 2025, Carrier contacted Staff regarding the Penalty Order and Carrier's unpaid UCR fees. Carrier stated that it ceased operations and requested Staff inactivate its USDOT profile.
- 6. Staff inactivated Carrier's USDOT profile. Furthermore, after a review of records, Staff could not find evidence the Carrier had operated in interstate commerce in 2025.
- 7. Based on the information provided, Staff asks the Commission to remove Carrier's designation as "suspended" and waive the \$300 civil fine.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order removing Carrier's designation as "suspended" and waiving \$300 civil fine in the Penalty Order issued August 5, 2025.
